I want to capture your true radiance and the groom's nervousness. I want to snap the photograph of you leaning into your husband's shoulder while you twirl your first steps as a married couple. These captured moments can be remembered year after year as you pull out your wedding book and relive those memories all over again.



GETTING READY FOR YOUR SPECIAL DAY



Between choosing the exact shade of roses and tasting everything from cake to hordorerves, you've got your hands full! Meeting caterers, florists, and musicians is tough enough, never mind negotiating the photographer scene. I strive to make your experience as stress free and memorable as is could possibly be. I begin by going over the time frame you are thinking about, and together we decide which package is the best fit for you.

On the day of the wedding one of the most important things to having your wedding portrait experience be as stress free as possible is to be sure everyone that is to be in the photographs is READY at the agreed photography time. I usually tell brides to tell everyone to be there 30 minutes before the actual scheduled time. If you are having your hair/makeup done professionally, the day of the wedding, allow an extra half hour or so above and beyond what your stylist/makeup artist actually tell you.



PLANNING YOUR DAY

If you choose to have your photographs done after the ceremony please have checked with your ceremony venue to be certain they don't mind staying open later. We try to take all photographs that do not include the bride and groom together before the ceremony, greatly reducing the time spent on formal photographs between the ceremony and the reception and allowing you to spend more time with your guest and enjoy your special day.

Regardless of when you choose to have your portraits taken, you will need full cooperation of your wedding party. Make sure that everyone knows when the photographs will be taken and that are completely ready. Once the photography has started we would like to ask that everyone involved stay in the venue until released. A great deal of time is wasted searching for people who are needing for photographs.

"What about the type of photography you see in the magazines?" These are bridal photos. If you choose a package that includes a bridal shoot this will greatly reduce the stress the day of the wedding in addition to giving you many more and creative photographs. We try to have these done a month or so before the wedding and many brides choose to have a framed canvas displayed at the wedding reception.

Candids are by far my favorite part of wedding photography. I love capturing a moment that you may not have even realized I was watching. I tend to hang back, watch, and wait. For me, a wedding is a natural event that should be photographed with as little interference as possible. Posed formal photographs will always be incorporated, but the little stolen moments are the ones I think you'll truly cherish, and I strive to record your day with as many of those as I can catch. As a woman, I know how important those little details are.

MEETING YOUR GROOM



MEETING AT THE ALTER

If you are seeing your groom for the first time at the alter, one of the biggest dilemmas that our couple face is when to take the formal photographs. Ideally, all formals would be completed prior to the wedding, allowing the couple to proceed directly to the reception. One way to reduce the amount of time the waiting guests need to endure is to do both sides of the wedding party separately prior to the ceremony and then the combined group following the service. Typically, I start with the groom and his groomsmen, followed by groom and parents and groom and family. This allows the bride a few moments more to get ready. Then after the groom has hidden himself away, we will shoot the bride and bridal party with bride and parents and bride and family. Then following the ceremony all we need to do is entire wedding party, bride and groom, and family shots.

FIRST LOOK

Another option is for the bride and groom to do a "first look". I can arrange a place for the groom to see the bride for the first time making it possible to do all of the photography before the wedding. Many brides choose to empty out the venue - or just have the bridal party and immediate family - and have the bride walk down the aisle to meet her groom just as she will do during the ceremony. This is a more intimate moment for the bride and groom as they get to see each other for the first time without the stress of everyone watching. This also provides a more relaxed intimate first look for the bride and groom and provides a great opportunity for beautiful photos.

ENGAGEMENT SESSIONS

The engagement session appears to be taking on a life of its own with today's photography-savvy couples. While the purpose of the session remains the same, what can be done with the images afterwards is limitless.

Photographers and couples alike find that the engagement session is a great way to learn to work together. Most photographers have learned the hard way that some couples are uncomfortable or freeze in front of the camera. Some couples are conditioned to smile every time a lens is turned their way, while others blink. This session helps photographers iron out those kinks—learning what the best way is to approach each couple, how best to direct or guide, and what kind of interaction works best.

In turn, you get a chance to work more intimately with the photographer who will be with you for the duration of your wedding day. For many people the only time they employ the services of a professional photographer is at their wedding. If their wedding photographs are important to them couples will spend a great deal of time choosing who will shoot their wedding and are willing to spend large sums of money to make sure it is done well. This is an important step to establishing a relationship of trust that is integral for photographers to best do their job. Openly communicating about what helps you relax or what makes you feel the most comfortable is very important at this stage. Your photographer wants to know how to best work with you to create the kinds of images you expect.

BRIDAL SESSIONS

Bridal portrait session is the perfect way to have a 'dress rehearsal' of everything you've planned for your wedding day. The wedding gown, flowers, hair, make-up, and all the other little things you've worked so hard to plan for, can be 'tested' together to make sure that there are no surprises on that special day. A perfect opportunity to take great images that you will cherish forever. Bridal Portraits are popular for displaying at the wedding registry table, at the reception sign-in table, custom sign-in books or you can turn one into a signature print for everyone to 'leave their mark' at the reception.

When your wedding guests walk into your reception facility, and they view your finished bridal portrait for the first time, I want you to hear your guests gasp in delight, see their eyes open wide, and watch their jaws hit the floor. I want the bridal portrait I create of you to put a smile on your face, and a tear in your mother's eye.

Bridal portraits are generally taken two to three months before the wedding, so that there is time to have a completed portrait on display at your reception.

BOUDOIR SESSIONS

We are now offering "Little Black Book" sessions as an add on to many of our wedding packages. Classy and tasteful boudoir photography is something every woman should do at least once in her life. 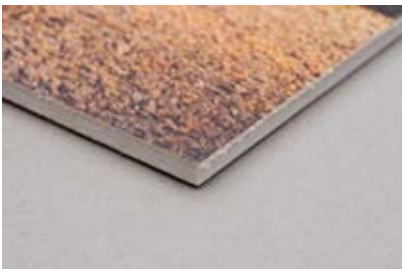

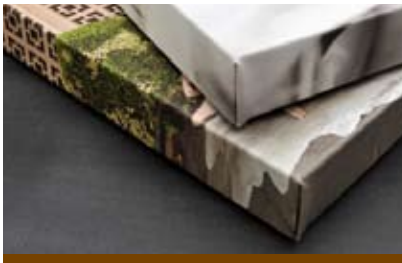
